The State of Kerala and its people have been facing the devastation and distress caused by the unprecedented flood situation, which has caused loss of hundreds of lives and damage to the property worth millions. Lakhs of people are displaced as well. A gigantic effort is required to be made on the part of countrymen for rehabilitation of the displaced people, involving reconstruction and repair of infrastructure, lost by the flood. As members of the judiciary, we share the pain and agony of the people of Kerala and as a humble gesture, at the initiative of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, it has been decided in the meeting of Hon'ble Administrative Committee, held on 20th August, 2018, that one day's salary of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, other Hon'ble Judges of the High Court and all Judicial Officers & staff members of the High Court and District Judiciary, will be contributed to the 'Chief Minister's Distress Relief Fund', Government of Kerala, for supporting the flood victims of Kerala. The Hon'ble the Chief Justice has also made appeal to the Bar Associations to make contribution in support of the cause.
